- WHAT:** The event kicks off with statements from local law enforcement representatives, elected officials and MADD. The "Be Safe - Be Smart- Get a Slurpee" initiative will also be announced. One hundred free Slurpee coupons will be distributed to safe boaters for proper life jacket use and safe drivers for proper seat belt use. Immediately following these statements, one hundred brand new life jackets will be given away to the first 100 people who arrive at the marina between 10:00-10:30am and sign a By Land or Sea Drive Alcohol Free pledge. Safe Summer promotional items and information packets will also be distributed to the public.

1-75 south to West Rd. exit for Grosse Isle/Trenton, go east to Allen Rd.  
Make a right on Allen Rd. and go south to Van Horn Rd.  
Make a left on Van Horn Rd. and go east. It will dead end at Jefferson.  
Make a left on Jefferson. The first light is Grosse Ile Parkway. Make a right. Proceed ½ mile and make a left into the entrance of Elizabeth Park Marina.
- WHY:** As the summer season heats up, the importance of safe roads, waterways and communities that are free of alcohol-related crashes and fatalities in Wayne and Monroe Counties will be celebrated. Proper life jacket use, the importance of seat belts and the strength of a multi-jurisdictional law enforcement team will also be highlighted.
